

PERFORM D.O.T. ALCOHOL SCREENING SERVICES (DRUG version also available)

AN INDEPENDENT STUDY PROGRAM

This independent study program is instruction that specifically meets and follows federal requirements and guidelines of 40 CFR Part 40. You may successfully accomplish the **training requirements of the DOT** in the convenience of your office or home.

DCs & CAs may complete the training requirements of the Department of Transportation (DOT) as a self-study course. You will learn comprehensive training information covering Screening Site Security, Screening Technician/Personnel, Site Requirements, Screening Procedures, Flaws, Fatal Flaws and Corrections, Requirements for the Technician - and ALL the info you need for DOT Alcohol Screening.

WHAT YOU NEED

This is perfect for learning at home or the office, saving you the time and expense of having to travel for training, and the luxury of studying at your own pace. Telephone support is also available during normal business hours M-F, of course, at no charge.

When you have completed the training portion, you will be required to also complete a Demonstration of Proficiency (5 consecutive error-free mock collects as defined by the DOT). **Contact your local emergency room or hospital to inquire about a "Qualified Person" who can proctor the Demonstration of Proficiency.** The Qualified Person is one that has:

- 1 - Complete the Train-th-Trainer Course for DOT alcohol testing
- 2 - Conducted DOT alcohol testing regularly for one year, or
- 3 - Has conducted training for DOT alcohol testing for one year

You will have up to 30 days after completion of training (this Independent Study program) to complete the Demonstration of Proficiency.

(An Independent Study course is also available for DOT Drug Testing training. Please inquire.)

One manual is assigned to one person. No two persons may use the same manual. A unique serial number is issued to each user.

This serial number is used to record all self-study, post-test submissions, and for the distribution of supplies for the Demonstration of Proficiency.

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This program prepares you as a DOT Screening Test Technician (STT) for performing DOT alcohol (initial, non-evidential) screening but you will be able to also perform non-DOT testing – this opens the door to working with any type of employer. This training follows and meets the DOT's guidelines of 49 CFR Part 40. Provide just one DOT service and see how the opportunity opens up for providing more DOT services for companies – it's 'Monday-Morning-put-it-to-practice' - an immediately marketable service. 12 million American workers are regulated by the DOT, meaning employers need your services. Since only 1% of all donors tested under the DOT alcohol screening program will test positive, the larger market for alcohol testing is in the initial (non-evidential) screening. Donors who test positive will be required to submit to confirmation testing, which is performed by a specially trained breath alcohol technician (BAT) usually found at the local emergency room. Note that the BAT must invest in approx \$2500 of evidential breath testing equipment (EBT). Unless you plan to focus a large portion of your clinical practice on providing DOT services to employers, you are better off training as an STT as opposed to a BAT. Otherwise, you may not realize a return-on-investment for the EBT for several years. DCs, CAs, DC staff persons, DC students and other Professionals should buy this program.
